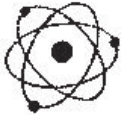

We have had a number of enquiries from people worried about the PDS scam that has been mentioned in newspapers and chain emails. Please see the following article for reassurance.

### A STATEMENT FROM PHONEPAYPLUS ABOUT THE CURRENT “POSTAL SCAM” CHAIN EMAIL



**PhonepayPlus** 

Regulating to build consumer trust in phone-paid services

PhonepayPlus, the phone-paid services regulator, is aware that a chain e-mail about an alleged postal scam is being circulated on the Internet The email refers to the Royal Mail, Trading Standards and ICSTIS (PhonepayPlus’ former name).

PhonepayPlus appreciates that recipients of the email may want to find out more information about the alleged scam and has therefore issued the following statement:

The chain email refers to a service that was shut down by us in December 2005. We subsequently fined the company that was operating the service, Studio Telecom (based in Belize), £10,000.

The service is **NO LONGER** running and has **NOT** been running since December 2005.

The email refers to a £15 charge for simply being connected to a recorded message. This is **NOT TRUE** - a £15 connection charge does **NOT** exist. The service in question actually cost £1.50 per minute and lasted six minutes, making a total cost of £9 if callers stayed on the line for the full six minutes.

You do **NOT** need to contact us, or the Royal Mail, about this service as it was stopped almost two years ago.

If you receive a copy of the email warning you about the alleged scam, please do **NOT** forward it to others. Instead, please forward this statement from PhonepayPlus.

## RECTORS LETTER

My dear friends,

### THE TURN OF THE YEAR

Someone with an interest in local history passed me a copy of a Vicar's letter from the December issue of a parish magazine of one of our villages, probably dating from the 1920s, remarking as they did so on how little has changed in all that time. I'm not so sure.

For a start ... but you don't want me to repeat what I've said many times before.

The Revd Boodle begins on the subject of Advent. I dare say that many readers of Signpost nowadays don't know what Advent is. In the 1920s, being a Christian country meant that life for pretty well everyone was bound up in a series of celebrations and seasons kept by the churches. I don't think that's the case any more.

And he writes "...one of the watchwords of Advent is the call to *awake*. We need it. Are we satisfied with the state of our own personal religion? Are we satisfied with the spiritual condition of those around us? ..." and a little later on "... If we put these questions to ourselves in all sincerity, we cannot be satisfied with the answer."

Are you satisfied with your own answers today?

In the 1920s, religion was a community matter. Nowadays, like almost everything else, it has been privatised. Nobody, not even the vicar, has the right to question another person's faith. And so churches decline and political correctness is in the ascendancy.

Then there is a reflection on Armistice Day, & how well it had been kept. I suppose the old vicar was writing his Christmas letter, as I am, about the middle of November. In the 1920s, the remembrance of the Great War was fresh. In the 2000s, the Great War may be old, but awareness of world conflict is too close for comfort.

And then there is the Vicar's Christmas message, "...as though it were something new and strange..."

And of course it is. In our world today an awful lot is new and strange - someone asked me yesterday what an iphone is, & I have no idea, nor has my spellchecker. And you may not know what a spellchecker is!

When Jesus was born, he came into a world which to him was new and strange, as of course it is for every child. And he made of this world and this life what he could. I hope you are able to make the best you can of your life. In our privatised world living for others rather than for self is not always easy.

So beyond Christmas into a new year. For many of us new years come far, far too fast. I'm writing about this one nearly two months before it happens, as though I'm wishing life away.

I look at the signs and am not convinced that it will be a happy one.

But it's what we make of it. In the Bible, the word "happy" means the same as the word "blessed".

If you can use the darkness of December Advent, to awaken the spirit of God in your life, if you can use the season of Christmas to plant the peace of the Christ-child in your life, if you can use the turn of the year to let the lessons of history take root in your life, if you can use the winter season to die to self and awaken to the needs of the whole world - because today's global village is way, way different from the world of the 1920s - then it might become a better year than any of us dreams possible.

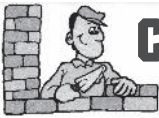

### NORMANBY-BY-SPITAL PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

At the Parish Council meeting held on Wednesday 24th October 2007, Councillors - Roy Bellamy, Adele Crowther, Adam Carter, David Kelsey and Ken Green were present. Apologies were received from Sally Mundy and Mick Crowe. Lewis Strange, PC Oaks, CPO Mc Faul and the Clerk were in attendance. Apologies were received from Jeff Summers.

The Police reported that there have been no serious crimes in our area. A resident has asked why the police had to have their siren going from Welton all the way to and through Normanby – the Police said it was a matter of safety. A warning regarding official looking letters arriving through the post to the individual person at that address, stating that they had won the French lottery and to send money to a certain address and then they would receive millions of pounds. Beware, as this is a scam.

been completed and the Clerk is writing to WLDC to see about getting Tree Preservation Orders put on them.

While our Post Office is not on the "hit list" it may still not be safe. A notice appeared in the Echo, giving the wrong time of the Remembrance Service – this will be corrected as soon as possible.

It was suggested numbering properties as the Emergency Services sometimes have difficulty in locating some properties. This will not be easy to achieve, but if any residents on Main Street object to this idea, could they please contact the Clerk (878148). All residents will be consulted before or even if this idea goes ahead.

Footpath No 3 is still on going. A property was built (in the 60's) over this footpath, before any decision had been reached as to its diversion route and a new route is to be found, which hopefully most people will be happy with. There may yet have to be a public enquiry.

Would all dog owners please keep their dogs on a lead, at least while walking along built up areas. This way the owner will be aware of when and where their dog fouls as it is very irresponsible for owners not to clear up after their dogs. Not only that, it is an offence and the Parish Council will report anyone who knowingly allows their dog to foul. Please do not have to make us do that.

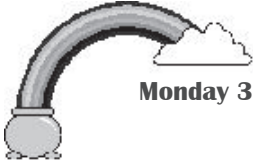

Various matters were discussed at the November meeting of Glenthams Parish Council. These included the reporting of the state of the footpath on the A139, the request for a replacement dog bin and a request to YEDL to clean up Little Hill after their recent works there.

The forthcoming Christmas Charity event was discussed and the Council agreed to provide the tree. Thanks go to the Landlord of the pub for his generosity regarding the siting of the tree and the provision of the sleigh.

The minutes were agreed with one amendment. For full copy of minutes please see the noticeboards.

The transfer of the S106 is to be carried out as soon as the title deeds are registered.

Several Councillors are to meet with Steve Wiles, LCC Highways, on 15<sup>th</sup> November to discuss the provision of a Speed Indicator Device and also to discuss Little Hill.

The automatic clock winding mechanism was discussed. Cllr Fox is to ascertain the current situation.

The Council had received notification of planning permission granted for application 120815. The Council had also received notification regarding inclusion in definitive map of public footpath from Church Close to Church Lane.

A Councillor had reported that the signs on Highfield Terrace were broken and Clerk was asked to report these.

Tenders had been received from various contractors for the grounds maintenance for 2008. Unfortunately, it became clear to the Council that they could not justify the financial outlay required to adopt the LCC maintained areas. New tenders are being sent out for the areas which the Council already maintain and LCC will continue to maintain the rest.

The Council discussed the budget for 2008/2009 but agreed to finalise this item after the new tenders have been received.

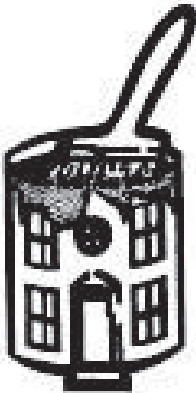

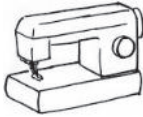

**Grow shrubs from cuttings**

Many different shrubs can be easily be propagated from hardwood cuttings.

You can start taking them now and over the next six weeks by using the woody stems that were formed this summer. Begin as soon as the leaves start to fall off the shrubs. Make the cuttings from strong new, woody stems about 8 inches long by making a cut just below a bud at the base and just above a bud at the top and insert them into some prepared soil outside. There is no need for a propagator or greenhouse. Many cuttings root without a rooting compound but it can encourage faster rooting and protect the cuttings from rotting. Push the cuttings into the prepared ground so that three quarters of them is below soil level. New growth should start next spring

#### WINTER & FOG DRIVING

\*Make sure the windscreen is completely clear of ice and snow before setting off. \*Drive slowly making any movements slowly and calmly. \*If you have to brake just pump the brakes gently this will help to reduce skidding. \*If you do skid then turn the wheel the opposite way and that should help to correct your car's position. \*Always leave plenty of room between you and the car in front. \*Make sure you have a spade, blanket and water in the car in case of emergencies. If you have a mobile phone, keep it charged and take it with you. \*Move off in second gear to get a better grip on the road surface. \*Try not to brake if you are on a patch of ice unless necessary. \*Call ahead and let someone know your expected time of arrival. \*If you are going up a steep hill use as high a gear as possible to stop your wheels from slipping. \*Make sure battery is fully charged. \*Drive slower and beware and watch carefully the road in front of you because fog can appear and disappear in an instant. \*Use rear fog lights when visibility reduced to 100m or less Only use front fog lights when visibility is seriously reduced – DO NOT HAVE YOUR FOG LIGHTS ON WHEN CONDITIONS ARE CLEAR OR AT NIGHT, IT IS AN OFFENCE. \*Turn radio off and open window slightly so you can hear other vehicles. \*Do not follow the car in front too closely. \*Do not use full beam head lights but dipped as these point to the road making it easier for you to see and for others to see you. \*Use windscreen wipers and demisters. If visibility reduced to less than 20/30m then your speed should be 20mph.

**Drink / Drive** – This is the season when many parties and dinners are held in celebration of Christmas, new year, family, friends and colleagues. Please THINK, DO NOT HAVE A DRINK, THEN DRIVE A VEHICLE, not for our sake but for your families. Ask your self “Is it worth it?”
