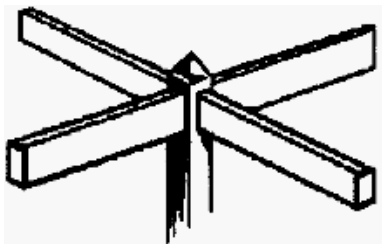

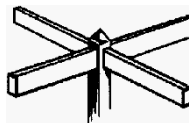

### **NORMANBY-BY-SPITAL PARISH COUNCIL NEWS**

The Annual Parish Meeting was held on May 9th in the school hall. All Councillors attended and there were 3 members of the public.

We hope to have a website for Normanby, possibly to cover the history of the village. Cllr Adele Crowther is looking into this

The speed indicating device (SID) will hopefully be in the village around the middle of June. There was a request for a dog bin near the Church and to have one of the two down Private Lane, moved to be placed near Sands Lane. It was noted a lot of gravel is collecting on the corner by the church and it was agreed to ask the Highway Department to sweep that area as well as Front Street and Main Street. Dog owners were requested to have their dog on a lead when they see another dog which is on the lead. A concern was raised whether there is a pit bull terrier in the village.

As there is no liaison between the school and the Parish Council, it was agreed to see if there is a vacancy for a school Governor and perhaps a Councillor could fill this post. It was agreed to replace the wooden notice board for an aluminium one as the Council has received a grant of £333 from Local Councillor Initiative Fund. This will be purchased shortly.

The Chairman reported that the main project this year had been to repair and clean the War Memorial. Jim Connor, together with Cllrs Adele Crowther and Ken Green were thanked for producing an excellent book called "They Went to War" and the exhibition held on November 11th last year. This year, on November 11th a service is being conducted in Normanby Church. The Chairman also said how dissatisfied he was over the resurfacing of the roads and that the Highway Department are coming out to check.

The Financial Report was approved – we had a balance of £1,283.21 at the year end – 31st March 2007.

The Annual Parish Council Meeting followed. Where Cllr Roy Bellamy was re-elected as Chairman and Cllr Mrs Adele Crowther was elected as Vice-Chairman.

The meeting ended at 8.25pm



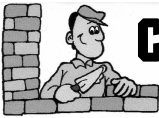

**A631** – County Cllr L Strange is working hard to try to get S.I.D. for the village. S.I.D. (so I am told) is a Speed Indicator Detector and has proved effective in other villages. A meeting with the Road Partnership and County Councillors is to be arranged.

**Parish Plan** – The Steering Group are in full flight, organising events and working extremely hard on this valuable project. Thanks go to all the members of the group (and their partners) for all their efforts. Personally I can't wait for the hog roast!

**Report from Village Hall** - Cllr D Wiseman reported that the Village Hall will be holding it's Annual meeting soon. The application for the new hall has been submitted so it is just a case of crossing fingers and toes and waiting....

**Notice Boards** - The two notice boards had deteriorated. The locks were rusted and the one on the High Street was practically unusable – except for by mice who were eating everything – even laminates. The boards now look smart having been repainted, had new backing inserted and new locks. The cost of these repairs was £157 which included the cost of new bolt cutters. Anyone got a bolt needing cutting?

**Forthcoming meetings** - The Council decided that they would try monthly meetings for the next year. There are lots of reasons for this, more paperwork arriving daily, planning applications can always then be considered at a full meeting and there isn't enough time between meetings to forget what happened at the last one.

The meeting will be held every second Thursday in the month, starting at 7.30pm. Everyone welcome. The next meeting will be on Thursday 14th June.

**Finance** -The books are at present being internally audited before submission to the external auditor Moore Stephens.

Currently the Council have £15878.68 in hand. £3100 of this is Parish Plan grant money to be spent on the projects which benefit the community enormously. Another sum has been set aside for the Village Hall a building without which the community would be bereft. The Council were granted £333 from the Councillor Initiative Fund which has been spent on a Bingo machine for the 55 club and some play equipment for the Mother and Toddler group.

Late night opening on a Tuesday with pre-bookable appointments until 8pm have now commenced and initial feedback appears very positive.

Could we remind parents of children who start school in September '07 to make an appointment for their child to have their pre-school booster vaccinations if they have not already done so.

Dispensary staff still continue to report an increasing amount of requests for repeat prescriptions to be issued "urgently" ( nine requests before 9.30am one morning recently ) We do require 48 hours ( two working days ) notice to process the repeat application and remind patients that this can be requested 24/7 by answerphone or by posting a request through the letterbox or dropped into the surgery. If a prescription needs to be sent to a chemist please remember to indicate this each time a request is made.

For those jetting off on holiday we would remind patients of the need to apply for travel advice giving as much notice as possible of travel intentions to ensure that appropriate timely vaccination schedules can be offered.
