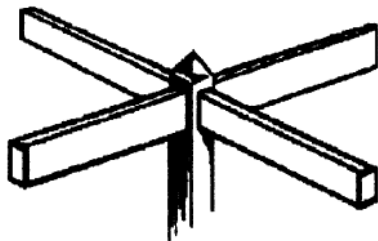

## RECTOR'S LETTER

My dear friends,

I'm writing this early in the week that leads up to Easter. A lot happens in Holy Week. I don't suppose that when Jesus rode into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday he particularly thought that this week would forever become known as Holy Week.

At the beginning of Holy Week, he is very busy. Day by day he taught in the temple. He met a lot of people, answered a lot of questions, and made a lot of enemies.

By the end of the week, he was doing nothing. On Good Friday.

You will receive this Signpost still during the Easter season. Easter Day was on April 16th this year, but the season lasts until beyond the end of May. From Easter onwards, Jesus is busier than ever, until Ascension Day, (May 25th. this year), when he decides that it is time to hand over.

Archbishop Bishop Desmond Tutu tells a story ...

When Jesus Christ returned to heaven, they say there was jollification, bank upon bank of archangels and angels, the whole myriad of the heavenly host praising God and singing alleluia to welcome him back. No, no, not everyone in heaven. There was a little angel, if you can imagine that, who looked a little concerned, with a worried frown on her forehead, who screwed up enough courage to go up to Jesus and say: "Jesus, you have done all that the Father wanted you to do down there. Who have you left to continue your work?" Jesus says "My disciples". And the little angel, quite aghast, says, "You don't mean -that lot?" And Jesus says "Uh huh", and the little angel says "What if they fail?" and Jesus says, "Well, if they fail, I have failed".

Would you call yourself a Christian? What makes you a Christian? Do you carry on the work of Jesus in the world today, or do you simply do your own thing?

If you wonder what on earth Christians are talking about when they say (or sing) that Jesus Christ is risen, then they mean this - that there still are people who are willing to be the Body of Christ for today, still doing what Jesus did, feeding the hungry, healing the sick, bringing good news to the down-hearted, showing hospitality to the outcasts, and so on.

Why should they do so? What makes them want to engage in tasks like that? Come to church and find out.

## Letter from The Ven. Dr. Tim Ellis


Dear Peter

As always, I hope this letter finds you well.

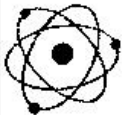

### PROTECT YOUR HOSTAS

Hostas are particularly vulnerable to slug and snail attack just as the new growth is emerging. If tightly curled leaves are nibbled by these pests, they'll unfurl looking like paper dollies. Use slug and snail control close to the plants to stop attacks. There's a variety of deterrents on the market, including slug pellets, biological controls (Nemaslug), copper slug tape, copper slug rings, hosta halos and Shocka mats, see [www.greengardener.co.uk](http://www.greengardener.co.uk)
