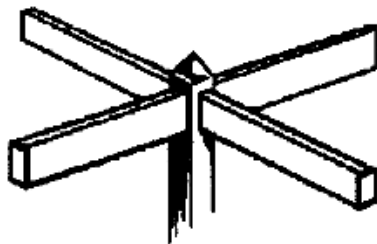



RECTOR'S LETTER

My dear friends,

To what purpose ...

I've never thought of myself as a serious fund-raiser. In fact I'm not. But during my first six years in these parishes we have completed four major fund-raising projects. A peal of bells has been installed in the church at Hackthorn, the first completely new peal in England since the Second World War (although most of the bells themselves are not new). You will read elsewhere in this Signpost about the good fortune of Spridlington's Historic Organ Restoration Appeal, and the work which will take place next year. Saxby Church has been restored to its original 18th-century colour scheme, & Owmbly Church has been made structurally sound in the nick of time. Now we are having our first long, hard look at Glenthams Church roof, and once again the noughts are piling up behind the pound sign.

Congratulations and many thanks are due to all those who have worked so hard in each case both to raise the required amounts of money (in total over £150,000) and to make sure that the actual work happened in the right manner at the right time, to committee members, secretaries, form-fillers, financial wizards, and those who have slaved away at all sorts of tasks.

We must have spent all this money on our churches because we believe in them.

Thirty years ago, when the going got tough, churches were declared redundant and closed. We have a redundant church at Normanby. Judging by the level of use it has, I'm not sure that redundant is the right word. There are also closed churches at Cold Hanworth and at Caenby, used quite differently from the reason they were built. There is the completely forgotten, demolished church of St. James West Firsby (now, where's that, and when and why was it demolished. Come to that, where is West Firsby? You'll find the answer in Saxby Church). And the old chapels in most of our villages.

Place matters. Whether these were holy sites before the churches were built (and many English churches are built on sacred sites much older than Christianity), or whether it's what has happened on these sites since the churches were built, I don't know, but the expression that comes to my mind is 'holy places'.

People have spent, and continue to spend, money on these holy places, because holy places matter.

There is something about sacred space. You can see it at its most awe-inspiring in Lincoln Cathedral. You might see it at its most exotic at some location in the Middle or Far East. You'll see it at its most rugged on the Celtic fringes of our land. These are places where prayer has been made valid.

Recent surveys indicate that prayer is much stronger than we might give credit for. Obviously, religious people pray. But so do many others who don't want to call themselves religious in a conventional sense. Perhaps that includes you.

Prayer is important. Someone once asked C.S. Lewis whether he thought prayer changed God. His reply was "I don't know Harry, but by God it changes me".

And that's the value of it. If you believe in God, then God uses prayer to turn us into the people God wants us to be. If you don't believe in God, then prayer works on you at a deep level to heighten awareness of things you might not have taken much notice of us.

Either way, prayer is a good thing. Have a go at it.

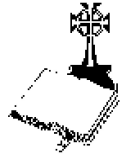
But where?

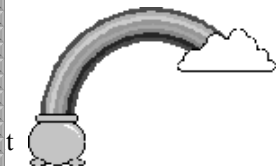

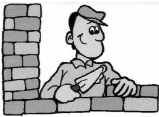
