RECTOR'S LETTER

My dear friends,

I'm not writing a letter this month. I have next year's diary (The Churchwarden's Yearbook 2009 – far better than the Vicars' equivalent), & the Foreword by the Bishop of Ely is so good that I'm publishing that instead, with the Bishop's permission. It's about Churchwardens...

In a parish in rural Yorkshire in the early nineteenth century, the Churchwarden stood on a hill with his walking-stick and top hat, ready to signal should he sight a curate making his way to the church. Much of rural church life was provided by itinerant curates, known as 'gallopers', who earned half a guinea per service, and sought to take as many as they could during the course of a Sunday.

Inevitably, before the legislation of the 1830s, when many clergy were non-resident, services were irregular and it was the Churchwarden's duty to alert the parish to the arrival of a hard-pressed curate.

One of the sights of Oxford was to sit on Magdalen Bridge on a Saturday afternoon to watch the curates leaving the city. Woodford records that, on the 9th December 1775, snow prevented the curates leaving for the parishes of Oxfordshire.

The principal problem of the church, throughout its long history, has been the shortage of clergy. It was true of the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries, and there was only a brief period, at the end of the nineteenth century, when numbers significantly increased. By the 1920s the discussion was again about the shortage of clergy and the amalgamation of parishes.

Churchwardens, as the principal lay officers of the church, have played a crucial role in sustaining the life of the church. Today's office-holders are the inheritors of a long tradition of care and devotion, both to the community and to the church building. In the present situation, their duties are more far-reaching and more complex than standing on the top of a hill to signal with a top hat the arrival of an itinerant curate.

Massively expensive to maintain, and only used (in the conventional understanding of the term) for relatively short periods, church buildings and everything they stand for, contradict the quantifiable judgements of everyday life. It is easy to denigrate the work that is done to maintain them in such terms as 'the ecclesiastical appendage of the National Trust'. Yet the truth is that our churches are eloquent and vital parts of the rural community which, at a time of rapid change, are deeply appreciated and loved. They are witnesses to the truth that beauty, peace, space, order and silence are important in human life, and it is through them that we approach the holiness and stillness of God.

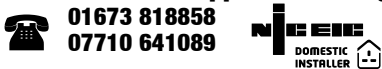

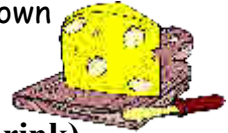

whether or not you are eligible. We are also able to give private vaccines to anyone who is not registered with this Practice as a patient – please ask for details.

Dispensary staff are asking if patients needing a repeat prescription could try, where possible, to write their requests on the repeat proforma that comes with their prescriptions. If this is lost there are slips of paper on the Dispensary desk for this or requests may, of course, always be made over the dedicated telephone order line. It would appear that many patients prefer to advise the staff personally of their repeat requests at the desk which is causing some delays for others waiting to collect medication.

It has been brought to our attention that there may be some confusion over the Community Nursing Team telephone number. It is, and has always been, 01673 860513. Several messages are being left on a regular basis on a similar number, which is a privately owned line, and the residents have alerted us to the fact recently.

We are participating in the Lincolnshire Face Fact Screening Programme to raise the awareness of Chlamydia screening, particularly in the under 25s and offering free access to Chlamydia testing and treatment (if needed). One in ten men and women under the age of twenty five who are tested are found to be infected. The test is simple and painless and totally voluntary. If you are interested please make an appointment with one of our nurses.

Finally, the government have recently published a White Paper, Pharmacy In England, which details the proposed changes to pharmaceutical legislation and a consultation document relating to these changes is out at the moment. Part of these changes involve proposals to alter the criteria for practices to provide a dispensing service to certain patients and if certain options are approved, will have significant impact on dispensing services in this practice. Details can be found on the website on <http://www.dh.gov.uk/consultations> and patients may wish to respond to the proposals on line or by writing as detailed in the report document.

Are there any rules about times when fireworks can be set off, including days other than 5th November? There are rules about letting off fireworks (except for gun caps and throw downs). The law states that it is not permissible to let off fireworks after 11pm at night up until 7am the next day except for on certain days. These days are 5th November, when fireworks are permitted until midnight, Chinese New Year, Diwali and New Years Eve when fireworks are permitted until 1am the next day. The penalties for this offence are imprisonment (maximum 6 months) and a substantial fine.

What are the rules relating to fireworks? It is an offence to: Possess adult fireworks (all fireworks except party poppers and sparklers) in a public place by anyone under

MARKET RASEN SURGERY

FLU CLINICS

Market Rasen Surgery will be running a dedicated flu clinic on 15 November. Clinic times are 0930-1600 hours by appointment only. Almost 3000 local patients are eligible to receive the vaccination. Eligible patients should contact the surgery in order to make an appointment. Patients unable to make the special Saturday clinic should contact the surgery as soon as possible in order to make an alternative appointment. The flu vaccine is recommended for people considered to be at risk of serious illness from flu and their carers. The flu vaccination may help protect against flu over the winter months and help prevent more serious illnesses as a result of flu. SURGERY'S DISPENSARY UNDER THREAT

Market Rasen Surgery's very popular dispensary will be forced to close if changes being considered by the government are put into place. The government has published a consultation document which outlines four options for dispensing doctors, such as Market Rasen Surgery:

Option One: leave things as they are. The doctors at Market Rasen Surgery are supporting Option One because they believe it is important that patients can continue to choose to get their medicines at their surgery.

Option Two: let Lincolnshire Primary Care Trust decide (this will not necessarily allow doctor dispensing).

Option Three and Option Four: only those surgeries which are more than a certain distance from a chemist, as yet unspecified by the government, would be able dispense to all their patients. In practice this would end most doctor dispensing.

Options Two and Three would mean the loss of the dispensary and some patient services, currently funded by the dispensary, at Market Rasen Surgery.

The doctors ask all patients who would like to save the dispensary to respond to the government's consultation document and to copy their response to their MP by Thursday, 20 November 2008.
