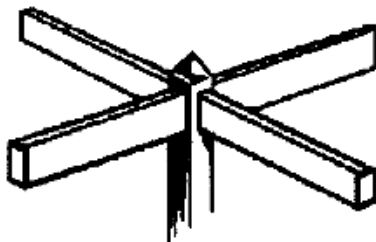

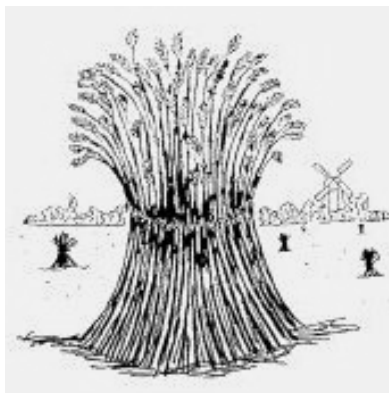



***Take a Pew***

What is it about Pews which rouses folk to such extremes of feeling for and against? After all, few of us would see them as the chair of choice when furnishing our own homes, so why insist on them in the House of God? Then again, is it the very fact that they are uncomfortable which prompts us to think of them as particularly appropriate for our times of contrition, penitence and prayer?

In some Churches the Pews are works of art in themselves, or survivors from the 17<sup>th</sup> Century or earlier so that their historic interest alone is sufficient to justify preserving them. However, others are no more beautiful than they are comfortable – and in terms of our medieval Churches they are often upstart innovations dating from the era of 19<sup>th</sup> Century “restorations”. Of course, whilst on the subject of Church History, we can recall that when most of our Churches were built the only seating would have been a stone bench around the walls for the old and infirm to use, hence the expression “the weakest go to the wall”. Otherwise, where we now have Pews there would have been an open space to be used for a range of community purposes in addition to worship. In other words, Pews seriously impacted on the original design and purpose of the building and that is what prompted the architectural historian and conservationist, Alec Clifton, to describe them as “the biggest single act of vandalism ever perpetrated on English Churches”. Incidentally, ask anyone what is the most impressive and awe-inspiring ecclesiastical building in Lincolnshire and they will immediately plump for the Cathedral where, of course, the Nave is a pew-free zone!

So what is it about Pews that makes people so attracted to them and eager to resist all attempts to remove them? The likely answer is that for as long as any of us can remember, Pews have been in Churches and they are part of our mental furniture when it comes to our sense of what a Church is, and what it must look like. We have sat on them for so long that we cannot imagine that there is or ever has been any alternative. Such associations are important and provide fixed points for us in a world of change and insecurity. They are to be treasured and treated with utmost seriousness.

On the other hand, to demand that things which hold such associations for us must preclude any change in this or future generations can be seen as short-sighted or even self-indulgent. This might especially be so when what is being proposed will effectively be an act of restoration rather than innovation. Also, it is worth noting that Archdeacons can give permission for re-ordering on a trial basis before any firm decisions are made.

So let us take a deep breath before getting too worked up about proposals to remove or re-locate Pews. They must be our servants rather than our masters when it comes to furthering God's purposes in the places where we live and work and worship. Ensuring that furnishings in our Churches are appropriate and fit for purpose in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century must be our over-riding concern, and we must at least entertain the possibility that there can be life after Pews, just as there was life in our Churches long before them.

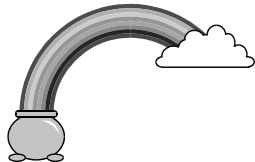

Various planning items were discussed.

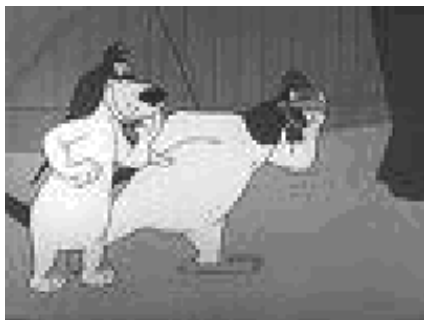

### GLENTHAM AND DISTRICT GARDENING CLUB.



A really nice day brought out a good crowd of old and new residents to the Annual Gardening Show.

As usual there was a very fine selection of exhibits and exhibitors had obviously made every effort considering the unusual weather conditions this year. There were several new entrants this year and it was a pleasure to see the success they had. A few new names were also added to the trophy recipients again something to applaud. Hopefully their success will encourage even more entrants to the event in future years. Well done to all the participants.

GERANIUMS can be propagated at most times of the year, but early September is the traditional time to root cuttings for overwintering.

Taken now, they'll develop roots in just a few weeks and the young plants will establish before the winter, which vastly increases their chance of survival.

Problems with a disease called blacklegis also less of a problem if you root the cuttings while it's still fairly warm. If you leave the job until autumn when it's cooler and damp, this fungal disease is more likely to attack.

You don't need any special growing conditions such as a heated propagator to root geranium cuttings — in fact, they're more liable to rot off in humid conditions. You don't even need rooting powder as geraniums root easily enough without it.

Once you've taken the cuttings, water the compost and keep the pot in a light place but out of direct sunlight. Only water again when the compost starts to dry out. Geraniums always grow better in slightly drier conditions - they dislike being wet.

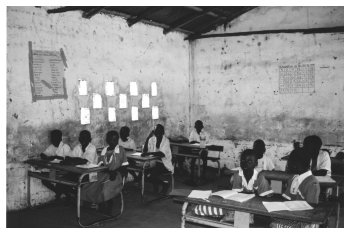

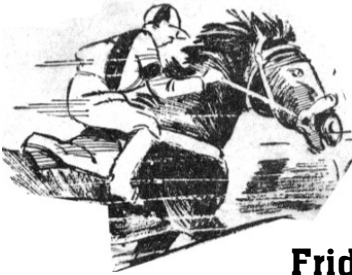
