**RECTOR'S LETTER**

My dear friends,

Summer's over, such as it was, and it's that time of year when we get back into the swing of things. For me it is a sharp learning curve as I get to know the communities to the West of the A15, to discover what makes you tick. For some it is harvest time, for others, it is back to school, work, or other routine.

Part of my routine is a letter each month into three magazines, Signpost, covering the villages from Hackthorn up to Glentham, Village Venture from Fillingham to Scampton, & the Newsletter for Burton & the Carltons. So a lot of you may read this. Come to that, none of you may!

So who am I & what do I do? I am Peter Godden. Formerly an organist and music teacher, I came to Lincoln Theological College in 1985, was ordained two years later, & have spent most but not all of my ministry since in or around Lincoln. Alison & I, together with David & Vanessa, live at Hackthorn, which is a good central position for all the parishes I now serve.

That means 13 churches, in 19 communities. Last month I wrote about the team of people who share this work with me. And that is how I see it. I cannot do everything that a vicar used to do. So these others don't just "help" the vicar, but take a real responsibility for the life of the local church.

There is a church in or near your village. It may look like a sleepy old building much of the time, but it does have a life of its own. It is home to a worshipping community. It is actually there for everyone in the village, which is why people come to church for christenings, weddings and funerals. It is yours, and I hope you feel free to use it. If it is open, and I wish they all could be, come and sit in it for a bit of peace and quiet, if your soul needs soothing.

I am one of a vanishing breed. Every year 500 vicars retire (and I haven't got that many years to go), but only 200 new ones are ordained. It's a good job that we have people like the ministry team.

Many of you know what it's like to live for years without a vicar. This is going to be a lot more common. When there are none of us left (well, not quite none, but you get my drift), these ancient buildings will still be here, saying that this has been a Christian country for a long time, and exhorting us still to keep the faith.

I don't know what your faith is. We're not as religious a society as we once were. But lots of people believe in God, or in goodness, or in the power of love. Lots of people know that there is a spiritual side to life. Lots of people strive in many ways for a better world. If you fit somewhere in here, then we are, I hope, on the same side.

Something more specific to finish with. Right at the very beginning of November, the Christian Church keeps All Souls Day, a time to remember, to thank God for, those who handed the tradition down to us, very often friends, relations, parents, brothers and sisters. We keep their memory in church on Sunday or Monday November 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup>. Come along and be part of that. It's good to have something to say thank you for.

## **NORMANBY & OWMBY**

### OWMBY BY SPITAL PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the Meeting held in the Parish Church on Monday, July 21 2008 at 7.30pm.

Present : Cllrs. G. D. Crompton-Howe; Mrs. J. M. Buckley; Mrs. D. Leah; D. M. Mellor; Mrs. M. E. Perry. The Clerk. + 3 Members of the Public

#### PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

1. Resident asked for an extra drain to be put on the east side of Normanby Rd. where flooding was occurring.

2. Resident suggested the following were needed at the east end of the village to improve road safety :

- i) Sign to indicate HGV's were turning in and out of Carter's yard.
- ii) White lines needed repainting on Saxby Rd, especially on the bend.
- iii) 30mph sign at eastern end of village needs moving further out as far as the village name sign on Saxby Rd.

3. Mr. Marsh, who along with Mr. B. Jois had kindly volunteered to operate the Speed Indicator Device which had provided a detailed analysis of types of vehicles and speeds recorded and commented that the noise of vehicles often gave the impression that they were traveling at a higher speed than that actually recorded.

He suggested it would be interesting to have the device again next year to enable an assessment of any differences in speed compliance.

The Chairman thanked both the volunteers for giving their time to conduct the exercise and for the detailed recordings, which were interesting.

4. Resident asked if a dog bin could be provided on Fen Rd. Chairman replied that one had already been ordered.

5. Concern was expressed at the apparent lack understanding and practice of basic rules when cycling on the road by some young people in the village, which put them and other road users in danger.

#### DECLARATION OF INTERESTS

Cllr Mellor declared an interest as a member of Owmbly PCC.

#### MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD 2.6.08

Resolved that the Minutes be signed as a correct record.

#### OUTSTANDING BUSINESS

1. Overgrown pf 4/5 had been mown by land owner.

2. Response from Normanby by Spital P.C. was noted. Cll Mrs Crowther had not contacted this council as yet.

Owmbly Councilors confirmed that its choice for a playing field was still land on the west side of Normanby Rd. and that both parish councils would need to accept joint management responsibility. Cllr Mrs. Perry advised that a preliminary meeting had been held to try and revive the ONSET project.

### FINANCE & ACCOUNTS FOR PAYMENT

The Council expressed thanks to Mrs Harrison for conducting the internal audit. No major problems had been identified.

Resolved that a second tender be obtained prior to the estimates meeting in November.

### WLDC STREET CLEANING PROPOSALS

Members discussed the proposals in the letter from W.L. Team Leader Street Scene.

Resolved that the Council sponsor a parish wide "litter pick" in April/May 2009.

Protective clothing and equipment to be requested from WLDC.

### HIGHWAY MATTERS

Resolved that the Highways Officer be invited to meet the Chairman to tour the village and discuss suggestions made during public participation; sitting for proposed bus shelter; possible tree planting sites and other minor repairs/ works required.

The meeting closed at 8.55pm.

## REPORT FROM GLENTHAM PARISH COUNCIL

### MEETING HELD ON THURSDAY 11<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2008

**CHAIRMAN'S REMARK'S** - The Chairman reported that he was standing for election as a District Councillor. A quote had been received for the proposed Village Hall road. Permeable surfacing was discussed and clerk was requested to obtain three quotes. The hedge at the top of Bishop Norton Road/Church Close is to be added to the grounds maintenance contract. Queries had been raised with regard to debris from the clearing of a dyke. The householder has confirmed that this will be removed. Queries were raised with regard to the verge opposite the Village Hall. Highways have laid new pipes and this area is due to be re-seeded.

**PARISHIONERS CONCERNS** The Council were asked if there was a register of TPO's and also if the bank near the ford could be made higher.

**COUNTY CLLR L STRANGE** County Cllr Strange reported that the S.I.D. would be installed before Christmas. Cllr Strange was involved in the recent bus timetabling and was asked if he would see if the Stagecoach bus, which comes through the village on a Saturday, would be able to stop and pick up. Cllr Strange was also asked if he would speak to Mr Wiles, LCC, to find out when the verge near to the Caenby Road junction would be lowered.

The Chair thanked County Councillor Strange for all his work on behalf of Glentham Parish.

**HIGHWAYS** Several items are in hand, including the bank slippage on Back Lane and the paving of the area round the noticeboard.

**VOLUNTEER WEEDERS NEEDED DESPERATELY** This plea brought no response. The Council are now looking for quotes from landscape gardeners.

**STEERING GROUP REPORT** Cllr Fox intimated that the plan will be ready to present for adoption in the early spring. Council will arrange a buffet evening for this event.

**CLOCK** This is not working *again*. Clerk to arrange service engineer to visit.

### **VILLAGE HALL REPORT**

Cllr D Wiseman reported that the Village Hall had been surveyed and declared structurally sound. There is a lot of cosmetic work to be done and the Village Hall Management Committee will consider this. County Cllr Strange offered to set up a meeting with another Village Hall Committee who have received grants and refurbished their hall.

I will then be looking at setting up two or three satellite groups covering the villages north of the area. Again, smaller areas with local people for local vil-

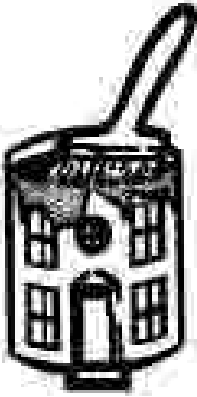

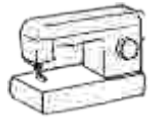
